## **DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF SACRAMENTO COUNTY**

CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
6/14/2018 - Curtis Hall. Sacramento

The regular monthly meeting of the Sacramento County Democratic Central Committee, held at the Sierra II Center's Curtis Hall on Thursday evening, June 14, 2018, was called to order at six fifteen P.M., Mr. Schanz being in the Chair and Mr. Becker as Secretary.

The Chair called the roll [see Attachment 1], and noted the presence of a quorum.

The June agenda was approved with a correction of a Scrivner's error regarding which month's agenda and minutes are to be approved.

The April minutes were adopted as distributed.

The Chair opened discussion about the pros and cons of continuing the monthly voter registration at the New Citizen's Ceremony. The Board is considering ending this as an official Party activity.

The Chair opened discussion about the pros and cons of continuing the annual State Fair booth. The Board is considering ending this as an official Party activity. Ms. Lewis moved to cancel the Party's fair booth, which was seconded. After discussion, the Chair put the question before the body, which was adopted.

The Chair ordered the Committee into Executive Session to consider a Disciplinary Hearing. Mr. Ramos has been appointed Case Manager for the proceeding, and conducted the hearing. Mr. Becker noted that the members being considered for discipline were given notice

of the disciplinary hearing by certified mail fourteen days before the meeting, along with the specific nature of the charges and a copy of the section of our bylaws concerning the disciplinary hearing process. Mr. Ramos outlined the charges against the three members. Messers. Hansen and Guerra. after notifying the Central Committee of their authority to speak on behalf of Mr. Woo, who was absent, entered a plea of No Contest for all three members. Mr. Ramos moved to accept their admission of guild, which was seconded and passed. The Chair gave the two members present an opportunity to speak in their defense, and for the absent member, and then asked them to leave the room for deliberation. Mr. Ramos moved to vacate the seats of the three members who pled No Contest, which was seconded. After debate, the Chair put the question of vacating the seats of the three members before the body, which passed.

The Chair delivered his report. The DPSC's coordinated campaign for Sherriff and District Attorney showed massive amounts of volunteerism and voter contact. With the help of the Voters Choice Act, voter turnout in Sacramento County is expected to have reached more than 45% in this election, which is more than double the turnout of the last primary election during a midterm cycle.

The Chair opened nominations for the election of a new Campaign Services Director.

Mr. Becker nominated Mr. Shaun Dillon, who accepted. Seeing no further nominations, the Chair asked for unanimous consent to elect Mr. Dillon by acclamation, which passed.

The Communications Committee reported that Clubs should email their events to Katie@SacDems.com to have it included on the County Party's Google calendar. Their next regular Committee meeting will be held at 6 P.M. on June 28th in the DPSC Office.

The Fundraising Committee reported that their next meeting will be held at 6 P.M. on June  $26^{th}$  in the DPSC Office.

The Resolutions Committee reported that their next Committee meeting will be held at 6 P.M. on June 21st in the DPSC Office.

The Rules Committee reported that the Central Committee is hereby noticed of a proposed bylaws amendment and a proposed Standing Rules amendment, the text of which were distributed to members in their entirety in

a written Rules Committee Report. The two proposals are also listed on the Party website. The Committee will continue considering an amendment stripping the requirement for Clubs to staff the State Fair booth from the Bylaws. The Committee is looking into creating a Community Action Director position to coordinate things such as tabling, protests, and event attendance. Their next regular Committee meeting will be held at 6 P.M. on June 18<sup>th</sup> in the DPSC Office.

The Campaign Services Committee reported that their next regular Campaign Services Committee meeting will be held at 6 P.M. on June  $25^{\rm rd}$  in the DPSC Office.

Club reports were heard.

Announcements were heard.

Upon unanimous consent, the Chair adjourned the meeting at thirteen minutes 'till nine o'clock.
