Yes, I am very informed regarding Elk Grove's Budget, which currently stands at \$293M. Our largest source of revenue is through the sales tax. Our largest expenditure from the city budget is for our police services.

Also, my ability to gain the trust, respect and support of my council colleagues, the entire Elk Grove Planning Commission, the Elk Grove Police Officers Association, the Sacramento Firefighters Association, local 522, and numerous community leaders clearly sets me apart from other candidates running to serve.

One of my greatest strengths is my ability to listen to stakeholders, work collaboratively with all involved, and then build consensus around a solution that works for most, if not all involved. This unique ability is due to my extensive knowledge of the planning, permitting, and other city processes and the trust I've built with the stakeholders working and living in Elk Grove.

I also believe that Town Halls are a great way to bring the community together, have a constructive dialogue about issues facing the community, and begin working through how to solve the day-to-day problems at hand.

As Mayor, I will ensure that they have the same rights as everyone.

However, from a moral and ethical standpoint, I do not support private prisons, believe that bail reform is needed to create a more just criminal justice system, and believe we must focus more resources on our 0 to 5 population to close the achievement gap and begin ending the school to prison pipeline.

Yes, I support capital punishment for crimes of extreme heinousness and after a thorough, fair, and extensive court process.

Elk Grove is currently developing a comprehensive strategy to address the homeless crisis that includes transitional housing, a partnership with the County to provide wrap-around services, a navigator program, a POP officer and other services.

Elk Grove must incentivize the building of more rental housing and more affordable housing options through permitting its construction.

Elk Grove already incentivizes affordable housing construction through city policies. As Mayor, I will also seek additional revenue and incentives to build affordable housing at the State Capitol and in Washington DC. Unfortunately, there are very few ways local jurisdictions can incentivize affordable housing construction, to end our housing crisis this must change.

I would be interested in learning more about how such a local ordinance would be structured as much of our housing policies are dictated by the state or federal government.

9.7 What is your plan to ensure that working class people have opportunities for home ownership?

Our housing crisis in California has been exacerbated by a lack of new housing construction, which has driven home prices through the roof and disrupted the rental housing market as well. Localities must find ways to increase the housing stock or few people will be able to afford home ownership in the future.

On the Elk Grove City Council I have worked to keep our construction fees low to help spur in-fill and new construction. Unfortunately, many other cities in the region have not followed suit, making Elk Grove one of the lowest priced areas to build more single-family homes. As Mayor, I will continue to strive to make sure Elk Grove continues to be a leader in new and in-fill construction of housing units to comply with our state housing requirements.

<u>Section 10 – Transportation and Public Transit</u>

10.1 Would you support a local sales tax measure to fund transportation and public transit? Please explain.

Yes, we must invest additional funding in our infrastructure for Elk Grove to be a fully, sustainable city.

I would prioritize regional transit system and transportation projects that promote a job center to reduce vehicle miles traveled.
