**RESOLUTION 2019-05** 

Reaffirming Support for By-District Elections in Elk Grove & Citrus Heights

WHEREAS, The California Democratic Party and Democratic Party of Sacramento County have called for

the replacement of at-large local election methods with district-based elections (CDP 2018 Platform:

Political Reform; DPSC Resolution 2017-21), in furtherance of the Democratic Party's commitment to

upholding voting rights protected by the California Voting Rights Act and the federal Voting Rights Act;

and

WHEREAS, The Cosumnes Community Services District utilizes an at-large election system but is

considering adopting by-district elections, and the City of Citrus Heights recently voted to move from at-

large to by-district elections; and

WHEREAS, By-district elections allow neighborhoods and diverse communities to elect representatives of

their choice, allow candidates to be viable without the need to fundraise prohibitively large sums of

money, and better reflects the values of the Democratic Party than at-large election methods;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Democratic Party of Sacramento County reaffirms its support for by-

district elections at all levels of local government, and calls on the Cosumnes Community Services District

to change its manner of election, by board action, from its current at-large election method to by-district

elections.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Democratic Party of Sacramento County commends the Citrus Heights

City Council for moving forward with adopting by-district elections, and urges the City to draw its council

boundaries in a manner that protects diverse communities of interest.
